



# WILD BIRD COOKIES

"They're for the birds!"

### INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups of wild bird seed (Wild Birds Unlimited delivers!)

- 1 package of unflavoured gelatine (Knox)
- 2 tbsp of cold water
- 1/3 cup of boiling water
- cookie cutters
- pen/pencil
- jute twine or yarn
- newspaper
- mixing bowl
- mixing spoon

### DIRECTIONS

In a mixing bowl, put 2 tbsp of cold water

pour in the package of unflavored gelatine and let it sit for 1 minute

Add 1/3 cup of boiling water and mix the gelatine until it is dissolved

Add 2 cups of your bird seed and mix it together until combined

Pack the bird seed into the cookie cutters

once fully packed, make a hole with a pen, pencil or marker  
put in the freezer for 2-4 hours to set

string the jute twine or yarn through the holes and go hang up your bird cookies!

\*for extra fun, you can further decorate your bird cookies with nut butter and dried berries to make them extra tasty for the birds.
